

# Title: Uploading project files from the HMI500 Series

## Summary

This document will explain how to upload a project file from an HMI500 series Operator Interface Terminal using EZware-500 programming software. It is highly recommended that owners of machinery containing HMI500 series products obtain a copy of EZware-500 and perform this procedure. This will ensure that a replacement unit can be installed and programmed on site, significantly reducing equipment downtime in the event that replacement of the HMI500 ever becomes necessary.

## Solution

1. Obtain a copy of the latest EZware-500 release and a configuration cable (Maple part # 7431-0098) from your local Maple Systems distributor or directly from Maple Systems. For a list of distributors in your area, please visit our website at [www.maple-systems.com](http://www.maple-systems.com), or call us at (425) 745-3229.
2. After installing and registering the EZware software, connect the configuration cable per the labeled connectors (the connector labeled as PLC is not used in this application).
3. Power the HMI from a suitable regulated 24VDC, 2A source.
4. To **upload** from the HMI:
  - In Windows, select Start-Programs-Maple Systems-EZware-500-EasyManager.
  - Select the Com port that the configuration cable is connected to, and then select **Project Download/Upload**
  - Click the **Upload** button. This will transfer the HMI's executable file to your PC.
  - Save the file as an eob format, under whatever name and location you choose. The file cannot be edited in the eob format, and can only be decompiled for editing if it was compiled under v2.00 or later.
5. To **download** to another HMI of the same model:
  - In Windows, select Start-Programs-Maple Systems-EZware-500-EasyManager.
  - Select the Com port that the configuration cable is connected to, and then select **Project Download/Upload**.
  - **Click Download.**
  - Select the file to upload to the HMI.
